FINANCIAL INFORMATION

HVAS strives to provide a high-quality Christian education. This is made possible by sound financial management and timely tuition payments from families. We are a non-profit organization and our operating budget is based on the support of three primary sources: the Oregon Conference of Seventh-day Adventists, subsidies from six constituent (local) Seventh-day Adventist churches and tuition. Subsidies help keep tuition as low as possible. The school reserves the right to change the rates charged at any time in order to meet changing economic conditions.

By enrolling a student at HVAS, the parent(s) or guardian accepts full financial responsibility for the student's tuition and fees. HVAS is committed to working with families to ensure that all students wishing to attend HVAS are provided with the opportunity to receive a Christian education.

PAYMENT PLANS

A financial agreement/payment plan must be in place via FACTS for auto payment of monthly tuition. Your payment plan must be finalized by <u>August 1</u> or your child's reserved space in the class will be canceled and you will need to reapply. If you require assistance in completing the online setup of your financial agreement/payment plan, please contact the HVAS office.

Families may select either the 5th or the 20th of the month for auto withdrawal payments. A credit card, debit card, or bank routing number may be used for FACTS payments. A **2.95% fee** is charged by FACTS for payments made by credit or debit card.

Families may choose from three payment plans

- PLAN 1 10 Monthly Payments (September June)
- PLAN 2 1 Payment The entire amount will be charged in September.
- PLAN 3 2 Payments Half of the tuition will be charged in September and the remaining half will be charged in January.

TUITION DISCOUNTS

Discounts available for qualifying families

- Multi-student discount (Grades K-8) Calculated starting with the oldest student first, then applying the appropriate discount for the next youngest child and so on.
 - o 2nd Child \$300 discount
 - o 3rd Child \$600 discount
 - o 4th Child \$900 discount
- Adventist Church Member Discount Adventist families are eligible for a \$1,000/student discount.

TUITION ASSISTANCE

HVAS works diligently to make a Christian education available to as many students and families as possible. Assistance is need-based and available from the resources listed below. All assistance is considered using the FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment application process (see below). Contact the school office if you need help completing the online application.

- FACTS GRANT & AID ASSESSMENT (Apply online at:
 https://online.factsmgt.com/grant-aid/inst/4BRM7/landing-page) Please be prepared to pay the FACTS service fee of \$40. This can be paid with credit/debit card or bank routing number. We encourage early submission as we can only apply the funds to the needs we know. The later the submission, the less assistance we will have available.
- EVERY CHILD DESERVES TO KNOW CHRIST GRANT This grant is available to
 qualifying incoming Kindergarten and 1st grade students as an introduction to
 Seventh-day Adventist education. If previously enrolled, the grant can be reapplied for
 as part of the student's continuing education. Grant requirements include: FACTS
 submission (see above), SDA church participation, school participation and family
 commitment.
- CHURCH STUDENT ASSISTANCE Seventh-day Adventist churches faithfully support
 HVAS. At each church's discretion, attendance, grades and current school payments
 may be requirements of assistance. Contact your church pastor or educational
 representative for details. Churches other than SDA may also offer financial aid
 opportunities, we encourage you to inquire.
- HVAS STUDENT ASSISTANCE HVAS Student Assistance is supported by alumni, friends of HVAS and our School Board who feel strongly about our school, it's mission and the children we serve. Based on your family's FACTS Assessment (see above), you may be eligible for HVAS Assistance.

FINANCIAL POLICIES

- The registration fee must be paid in full before a student may begin school. This payment is made through FACTS at the time of re-enrollment of current students or at the time of enrollment of new students.
- Invoices for Before and After School Care (BASC) charges and other incidental charges (such as for school supplies, hot lunch, milk, or field trips) will be sent separately through FACTS and may be paid via auto payment or by parent/guardian initiation. Incidental charges are billed on the 5th of each month with payment due by the 20th.
- Students who enter or leave school mid-year will receive a prorated bill which is calculated using a daily tuition rate. The daily tuition is determined by dividing the total tuition by 175.
- If a scheduled payment is unable to be completed due to insufficient funds, a \$30
 FACTS fee will be added to the payment amount. If the second attempt to process the
 same payment is refused due to insufficient funds, a \$25 HVAS fee will be added.
- Past due accounts If circumstances arise that would prevent you from honoring your financial commitment to HVAS, it is important to communicate with the school. HVAS reserves the right to require that any student with a past due account withdraw from school.
 - 60 Days Past Due the family must contact the business manager or principal to explain the situation and make appropriate arrangements
 - 90 Days Past Due Any account that is 90+ days past due will be taken to the Finance Committee for discussion. The family must meet with the business manager to sign a written payment plan for bringing the account up to date.
 - 120 Days Past Due Any account 120+ days past due will be taken to the School Board for discussion.
 - All past due accounts are required to be paid in full before a student will be considered as enrolled for the upcoming school year. Pre-registration becomes invalid after **August 1** in the event of an outstanding balance.
- Any outstanding account for students who leave the school that is not paid within 6
 months and for which payment arrangements have not been made, will be turned over
 to a collection agency. All related fees will be added to the account.

OFF-CAMPUS STUDENT FEES

HVAS attempts to accommodate requests from parents of homeschooled children whenever possible. These students may be enriched by limited participation in school activities.
