### As a Reminder:

#### **\*\*PLEASE READ: Pick Up Times\*\***

We have been contacted with concerns regarding the vehicles backed up on Kelso Road each day at dismissal time. In an effort to alleviate this problem,

**the pick-up time for any student in gr.5-8 is 3:25.** If you have a student in gr.5-8 (even if you have students in lower grades), PLEASE do not enter the vehicle pick-up line before 3:25 (or 12:55 on Fridays. We ask parents of gr.5-8 students to please wait in the church parking lot if you arrive before 3:25.

As a courtesy, it would be especially gracious for ANY driver, if one sees cars backed up on Kelso Road as one approaches, to pull into the church parking lot and wait a few minutes. Also, please avoid blocking a lane while entering the pick-up lanes so that as many cars as possible are able to wait in the lanes. We are hoping these measures will solve this issue, but we may make other adjustments to pick up procedures, if needed. Thank you for your help with this!

## **Re-enrollment has begun!**

An email with information on early re-enrollment for the 2022-23 school year was sent out earlier this week. Re-enrollment is offered for K-8 students with an early registration discount of \$100 per student, through March 18. Early re-enrollment saves your child's seat in his/her class for next year and allows Hood View to plan ahead for the 2022-23 school year.
